To avoid a penalty please pay taxes prior to June 30th deadline. Payments received after June 30th will be subject to a 3% penalty to current year taxes for each month they are outstanding. (July August, Sept, October, November December, an 18% penalty will be added to all tax rolls that have a outstanding balance owing January 1, 2018 . Payments can be mailed to the Village office or dropped off at the Village box. The June 30th Deadline applies for payments made via the Village box

Weekly Household Garbage Collection reminders

Please Note: Collection is limited to household waste/garbage ONLY, with <u>a</u> <u>maximum of 5 bags per household</u>. All household waste MUST BE bagged. Items that <u>will not</u> be collected include:

- bags weighing more than 50lbs
- bags that have sharp items sticking out of them (or anything else deemed to be unsafe for Village workers to handle)
- bags that contain items other than general household waste (toxic materials, building materials, yard waste, tree clippings, electronics, furniture etc....)

In the event that you need to dispose of these items or have more than 5 bags of household waste, you can take these items to **Highway 43 East Waste Commission - fees apply. For more information you can contact Highway 43 East Waste Commission at 780-967-3466** for hours of operation and disposal fees. Highway 43 East is located 7 km west on Hwy 43 from the Hwy 33 Junction. Recyclables can also be brought free of charge to the Highway 43 East Waste Commission (you will have to sort recyclables into appropriate bins).

Administration asks that you treat Village workers with respect as they work hard to keep the Village clean.

Dangerous Trees

We have had an eventful spring high winds have taken down power lines due to falling/leaning trees in the Village. The Village would like to remind residents the importance of removing dead or leaning trees from private property. Each property owner is responsible for the trees on their own property and will be liable for damage caused by falling trees onto neighbouring properties.

Village Weed Inspector

This Summer the Village's weed inspector will be visiting all properties informing and educating residents. The Village's Weed Inspector has the authority to enter private property to inspect for noxious and prohibited weeds. Those properties that are found to have such weeds will receive a door hanger with further instructions. The owner of the property must clear their property of these weeds.

IMPORTANT Tax Payment Plan (TPP)

Please be advised that everyone currently enrolled in the TPP will be receiving a letter with their tax notice stating the amount of their new payment. The Village requires those residents enrolled on the TPP to send in 12 postdated cheques starting June 2017 – May 2018 (one for each month dated the last day of each month (For example the June tax payment cheque should be dated June 30 and so on for following months. The amount must be the exact amount as stated in the letter that will come with your tax notice. 12 postdated cheques must be received into the Village office prior to June 30th. Missed payments or cheques will disqualify you from the TPP plan.
