

**SUMMER VILLAGE OF SANDY BEACH
BYLAW NO. 06-2008**

**BEING A BYLAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF SANDY BEACH, IN THE
PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO CONTROL LAND USE.**

WHEREAS a Council of the Municipality may, pursuant to Section 7 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, and any amendments thereto, pass bylaws amending the Land Use Bylaw;

WHEREAS the Summer Village of Sandy Beach wishes to provide for and regulate the sale of alcohol at private liquor outlets within the Municipality under Land Use Bylaw No. 99-04; and

WHEREAS the use of a private liquor outlet is excluded from both the permitted or discretionary uses under Section 57 (C1 – Commercial District) of the Summer Village of Sandy Beach Land Use Bylaw No. 99-04; and

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Summer Village of Sandy Beach, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

The Summer Village of Sandy Beach Land Use Bylaw No. 99-04 is hereby amended by making the following changes:

1. adding to Section 57(2), as a Discretionary Use,
"Private liquor outlet"

AND WHEREAS this Bylaw comes into full force and effect upon third reading.

READ A FIRST TIME this 9th day of September 2008.

READ A SECOND TIME this 9th day of December 2008.

READ A THIRD AND FINAL TIME this 19th day of December 2008.
