

BYLAW #179-1992

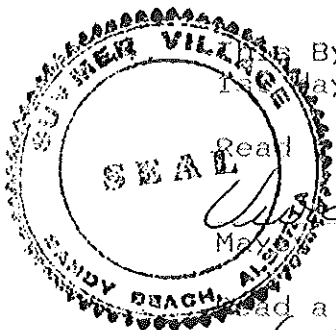
A BYLAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF SANDY BEACH IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONTROL AND REGULATION OF JET BOATS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF SANDY BEACH.

WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980, authorizes the Council to pass bylaws for the peace, order and good government of the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Summer Village of Sandy Beach duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. That this Bylaw may be cited as "The Jet Boat Bylaw."
2. That "Jet Boats" are prohibited within the corporate limits of the Summer Village of Sandy Beach.
3. That the minimum fine for violation of this bylaw shall be \$500.00.

This Bylaw shall come into force at 12:01 A.M. on the 1st day of ~~MAY~~<sup>APRIL</sup>, 1992.
