

BYLAW #188-1993

A BYLAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF SANDY BEACH IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AMEND BYLAW #178-1992 WHICH PROVIDES FOR THE CONTROL AND REGULATION OF PUBLIC USAGE OF PARKS WITHIN THE SUMMER VILLAGE

WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980, authorizes the Council to pass bylaws respecting all matters pertaining to the control and operation of public places within the municipality, and

WHEREAS there are public places with facilities that are available to the general public within the corporate limits of the Summer Village of Sandy Beach, and

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable and expedient and in the public interest to provide for the control and protection of the facilities and of the public using the facilities;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Summer Village of Sandy Beach duly assembled enacts as follows:


1. That this Bylaw may be cited as "The Parks Amendment Bylaw."
2. That Bylaw #178-1992 Section 5, be amended to read "between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 11:00 P.M."
3. This Bylaw shall come into force at 12:01 A.M. on the date of its passage.
