The SUMMER VILLAGE of SANDY BEACH BYLAW 03-2021

A BYLAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF SANDY BEACH IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO ESTABLISH THE POSITION OF ASSESSOR as a DESIGNATED OFFICER.

Whereas, pursuant to the provisions of section 284.2(1) of the Municipal Government Act, the Council may pass a bylaw to establish one of more positions to carry out the powers, duties, and functions of a designated officer.

Now therefore, the Council of the Summer Village of Sandy Beach in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That the position of *Assessor* be established as a designated officer to carry out the duties and responsibilities of an assessor as designated in the Municipal Government Act.
- 2. That this Bylaw shall take effect on the date of the third and final reading.
- 3. Bylaw 2003-02 is hereby repealed upon the signing of this Bylaw.
